

# Windows 8

# Steps to log onto the IWC wireless network


Log in to your Windows 8 device and you should be on the main screen (see below).



Type "wireless" and click **Set up a connection or Network**.




#### Click Manually connect to a wireless network.




For Network name type **IWCInternet** - must be exactly as seen here including capitalization.

#### For Security type choose WPA2-Enterprise




Then click Next.

## Click Change connection settings.




## Then click **Advanced settings**.



Check Specify authentication mode and choose User authentication in the drop down box.


Click Save credentials.




Type your IWC username and password in the dialog box and click **OK** and then **OK** again.



You should now have returned to the screen below. Make sure **Microsoft Protected EAP (PEAP)** is selected and click the **Settings** button.



Uncheck the box - Verify the server's identity by validating the certificate. Then click Configure.



Uncheck the box seen below, then click **OK**, and **OK** again. Click **OK** a third time and Close the **Manually Connect to a**Wireless Network box. Your connection is now complete. It should connect automatically within a minute or two. This only needs done once for wireless access in all buildings on campus.
